



Cleaning Clothing

For cleaning Modern technical clothing fabrics such as those used in our force 12 range we recommend the use of use 30 degree cleaner and proofer from Grangers.

Wash your Clothing as specified on the manufacturers label refrain from using detergents and use warm water never hot as this could affect taped seals. Always use a sponge - never scrub heavily soiled areas if mud has dried you can use a soft nylon brush to remove excess prior to washing

Take extra care with zips never force them if debris prevents zips from operating do not force the zip instead soak and use a soft nylon brush to lift the dirt

Once cleaned its advisable to re proof your clothing using a designated Durable water repellency there are several ways that this can be applied.

1. As a dual cleaner and proofer (recommended)
2. As a separate wash cycle once cleaned
3. Sprayed on after washing

Again follow the instructions on the bottle we recommend the dual cleaner and proofer as its less wear and tear on the garments during the washing cycles and they are designed to be effective in low temperatures.

We advise prior to washing technical fabrics using Granger's products you ensure that the detergent drawer on your machine has been rinsed thoroughly to remove powder deposits and the machine is dry run to clean the system through of any build ups of your regular cleaning powders etc.

We advise regular cleaning of breathable fabrics remember modern breathable fabrics work best when they are clean.
